<b>1</b>	<b>Welcome / Celebrations</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Members in attendance – Mark Allen, Abby Roehm, Sean Burton, Meg Moores, Madonna Dormaier</li><li>▪ Meeting called to order at 1pm</li></ul>
<b>2</b>	<b>UIP/NIC update</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Mr. Allen presented the results of the first semester goals.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Elementary: 100% of students met both goals for the semester.</li><li>○ Secondary: TBD (grade connections in the first week back from break)</li></ul></li><li>▪ The UIP and NIC plans will be consolidated eventually. There will be a hard copy of the UIP available at the next meeting.</li></ul>
<b>3</b>	<b>Panorama data</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ The Panorama Survey is a tool the school district uses to measure how students feel about the school, staff and community. There was distinction between elementary and secondary. Elementary overall scored lower in favorable responses over last year while secondary scored higher than last and above district in favorable responses. Many questions as to what determines a student's perception. There was discussion regarding how our small class sizes affect the data and that specific questions on the survey weren't very relevant to our school.</li></ul>
<b>4</b>	<b>OWL update</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ There was conversation about timelines and the minimal impact the program will have on our day to day routine. Schedules were reviewed for comment.</li><li>▪ Mr. Allen mentioned that they are looking into ways to possibly include the local Gateway community experts for instruction. Those speakers would present lessons about our area or subjects they specialize in (agriculture, ranching)</li></ul>
